- 4) Have you ever had someone try to get you to *know* through “cleverly devised myths” (verse 16)?
- 5) What is the most effective way to get you to *know* something?
- 6) How does Peter *know* in verse 16??
- 7) What is the difference between true and false prophecy in verses 20-21?
- 8) With the emphasis on “*knowing*” and “remembering” in chapter one, what do we expect to come next in chapter 2?
