3. Who/what are you tempted to worship (44:9, 19; 47:10; Rev. 19:10)?
4. God will not share his glory (42:8, 48:11). What are the consequences when we claim his title (47:8-11)?
5. Why does God keep Israel (43:7, 44:1-2, 46:10, 48:11)?
6. Who gets to decide who you are and what you do (45:9-10)? What is the fallacy of us deciding (47:10-11)?
7. If God continues to choose Israel yet she is stubborn and has a forehead of brass (48:4), what does that tell us about his patience for us (2 Peter 3:9)?
