- 5. What atmosphere is established with v.1 & v.11 (see also Ps. 23, 95:7)? How have you experienced The Lord like v.11?
- 6. How does knowing that your comforting shepherd also created everything (v.12, 26, 28), knows everything (v.13-14), is over the nations (v.15-17, 23), and keeps everything ordered, (v.26) build our trust in him?
- 7. Even though we know verses 18 & 25 what are you tempted to compare God to or trust in?
- 8. Does verse 27 ever describe you?
- 9. Are you waiting on the Lord or pushing ahead in your own strength (v. 31)?
