- 4. How were the Berean Jews more noble (17:11)? How is Paul's approach with idolatrous Gentiles different (17:23-31)?
- 5. Why is the gospel message received some places but not others?
- 6. Do you suppose a church was planted in Athens? (17:34 & 1 Thess. 3:1)
- 7. The Jews didn't seem to be receptive in Athens and Paul's spirit was provoked by the idolatry. Could those things be related? (1 Cor. 1:23)
- 8. How is our culture like theirs in 17:21?
