4. How does the Lord come to Elijah in verses 9-13? What does the Lord say in verses 9 & 13? Can you relate?
5. Discuss the conversation between Elijah and the Lord in vs 14-18. What does Elijah want? What does the Lord want? Does Elijah have a clear view of national events?
6. Elijah wants to die (v. 4) but how do his days on this earth end (2 Kings 2:11)?
7. How does 1 Kings 19 help us navigate our lives today?
